Thirtieth Flight of the Space Shuttle Atlantis

These packets of Jalapeño Ketchup were flown aboard the United States

Space Shuttle, Atlantis, to the Hubble Space Telescope. Atlantis launched
at 2:01 p.m. EDT, May 11, 2009, from Pad 39A at the Kennedy Space
Center, Florida. At 11:39 a.m. EDT, May 24, 2009, Atlantis landed at
Edwards Air Force Base, California having traveled 197 Earth orbits.

Atlantis reached a maximum altitude of 350 statute miles and a maximum speed of 17,800 miles per hour. The flight duration lasted 12 days, 21 hours, 37 minutes, 9 seconds covering a total distance of 5,276,000 miles.
